RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The project staff recommends that all properties inventoried as warranting further study as a possible National Register nomination and as not warranting such study be added to the State of Oklahoma Landmarks Inventory.

2. The staff also recommends that properties inventoried as possessing National Register potential be fashioned into three thematic nominations, one each for the different management regions. Included initially in the nominations should be only those properties that are 50 years old; the rest should be added as they come of age.

3. The project team would recommend as well that a special nomination to the National Register be prepared for the Holy City facility in the Wichita Mountains near Lawton. That resource, among other things, raises the interesting question of the separation of church and state.

4. The staff suggests too that the State Historic Preservation office prepare press releases for local newspapers identifying WPA resources on a county-wide basis.

5. The project team also recommends that steps be taken to facilitate a field survey of WPA resources of the grounds of Fort Sill near Lawton, Oklahoma. Our surveyor for that region, Kim Jones, was not permitted to tour the premises.

6. Finally, the project staff recommends that surveys of other structures built by government relief and other agencies in the 1930s in Oklahoma be undertaken. This would include non-civil

engineering facilities built by the PWA, CCC, NYA, Resettlement Administration, CWA, FERA, OFERA, and the U.S. Post Office.

SUMMARY

The WPA Thematic Survey (Phase III), conducted between Sept. 1, 1986 and Aug. 30, 1987, undertook to identify and classify extant WPA resources in a 27 county region in central, southwestern, and panhandle Oklahoma, or Management Regions #1, #6, and #7. This survey was conducted because of the unique characteristics of WPA-built structures and because of the historical significance of the construction activities of the relief agency. It was undertaken as well because many WPA resources in the study area have deteriorated or have been demolished. Preliminary research identified 1,118 possible WPA-built sites. Field work assessed 1,046 of these, of which 357 were recommended as warranting further study for possible nomination to the National Register of Historic Places and 158 were evaluated as meriting no further study.

A major source to identify the type of projects undertaken by the WPA in Oklahoma and elsewhere in the United States.

Oklahoma State Government Documents

A book of plans available to school boards for the construction of new schools. Enables the researcher to identify patterns of WPA school structures.

An excellent source to determine demographic changes in Oklahoma resulting from the depression.
