HARTSHORNE SCHOOL BUS GARAGE

LOCATION: Kali In 1a and 9th Streets, Hartshorne, Oklahoma 040, Pittsburg County 121

CLASSIFICATION: building; private; public acquisition--N/A; occupied; present use--mechanical shop

OWNER: Mr. James Phillips, Box 229, Hartshorne, OK 74547

DESCRIPTION: fair condition; altered; original site

Measuring 27 feet by 62 feet, the structure is constructed of rusticated and coursed native sandstone and has a gable roof line. There were initially were six bus stalls, but two have since been enclosed with concrete blocks while another has been enclosed with the addition of another room to the building on the north end. The alterations generally detract from the architectural integrity of the building. The rock on the front has been painted white.

SIGNIFICANCE: date of construction and architect uncertain

The building is interesting because not all that many bus barns remain that were constructed by the WPA.
