LOCATION: Vicinity of Soper, Oklahoma 040, Choctaw County 023; SW 1/4, Sec. 26, T 5 S, R 15 E

CLASSIFICATION: structures; private; public acquisition--N/A; occupied; present use--agriculture

DESCRIPTION: poor condition; unaltered; original site

The buildings constitute a basic rural school unit. The school house is constructed of cut and rusticated sandstone laid in courses. It was designed as a two room building. The adjacent teacherage is also of stone. The east wall of the school building has been removed.

SIGNIFICANCE: 1940; unknown.

The campus structures constitute a good example of a rural educational facility.
