LOCATION: Vicinity of Hartshorne, Oklahoma 040, Pittsburg County 121; NW 1/4, Sec. 12, T 2 N, R 16 E

CLASSIFICATION: building; private; public acquisition--N/A; unoccupied; present use--abandoned

OWNER: Ray Freeman, Rural Route, Hartshorne, OK 74547

DESCRIPTION: ruins; unaltered; original site

Designed as a two room school, the Weathers building was constructed from cut and uncut native stone. Only the walls stand today.

SIGNIFICANCE: 1936-1937; unknown architect

It is a classic example of a two-room school building. And as remote as it is, it helped unemployed workers to have jobs when there were none in the region during the depression.
