



NUMBER OF INHABITANTS

Population of the State.—The Territory of Oklahoma was organized in 1890 from the western part of Indian Territory and the Public Land Strip, originally a part of Texas. In 1893 the Territory of Oklahoma was increased by the addition of the Cherokee Outlet, which fixed the present northern boundary. In 1907 Oklahoma Territory and the remaining part of Indian Territory were combined and admitted to the Union as the forty-sixth State with boundaries substantially as at present. The population of Oklahoma on April 1, 1940, according to the Sixteenth Census, was 2,336,434, which represents a decrease of 59,606, or 2.5 percent, as compared with the population on April 1, 1930. The total land area of the State, as shown in table 3, is 69,283 square miles. The average number of inhabitants per square mile in 1940 was 33.7, as compared with 34.6 in 1930.

Table 1 shows the population of Oklahoma from 1890, the year in which the Territory of Oklahoma was first

separately enumerated, to 1940, together with the increase or decrease during each decade. This table also presents the population of Oklahoma and Indian Territory at the special census taken as of July 1, 1907, shortly before the State of Oklahoma was admitted to the Union. The urban and rural population of the State at each decennial census is presented in this table and is also shown graphically in the accompanying chart. The urban population of Oklahoma consists of those persons living in incorporated places of 2,500 or more, the remainder of the population being classified as rural. The urban and rural areas are not necessarily constant from one census to the next, since new places are added to the urban list from time to time as they attain a population of 2,500 or more. Places are likewise taken off the urban list when, through decline in population, they fall below this limit. For example, Madill qualified as urban in 1920 and 1940, but not in 1930.



Geographic subdivisions.—In tables 2 to 5 the population of Oklahoma is shown by counties, townships, cities, and towns, with some comparative figures from

previous censuses. Table 6 gives the population of cities by wards. Data for the metropolitan districts are presented in tables 7 and 7-A and for the census tracts of Oklahoma City and its adjacent areas in table 8.

Cities of 10,000 or more.—There are 21 cities in the State that had a population of 10,000 or more in 1940. Table 2 shows the population of these cities at each census for which figures are available, together with the increase or decrease during each decade. Oklahoma City, the capital and largest city, had a population in 1940 of 204,424.

Counties.—Table 3 shows the population of the 77 counties of Oklahoma from 1920 to 1940, together with the land area of each county and its population per square mile in 1940. The land areas given here are the result of new measurements recently compiled and differ somewhat from those published in earlier census

reports. Twenty-nine of these counties increased in population between 1930 and 1940, and forty-eight decreased. No new counties have been organized, and there have been no changes in county boundaries since the census of 1930. This table also presents the urban and rural population of each county for 1940 and 1930.

Minor civil divisions.—To the primary political divisions into which the counties are subdivided the Census Bureau applies the general term "minor civil divisions." The primary divisions of the counties in Oklahoma are the townships, cities, and towns. (Fort Sill Military Reservation and Platt National Park are also classified as primary divisions.) There are 135 cities and 384 towns; all but 2 of these cities (Muskogee and Vinita) and all of the towns are primary divisions. The two cities are coextensive with the townships in which they are located and form secondary divisions of these minor civil divisions.

Table 4 shows the population of each county by townships, cities, and towns for the last three censuses. The population of the secondary cities is shown in *italics* under the population of the primary divisions in which they are respectively located. Where a city or town is located partly in one county and partly in another, the part in a given county is presented in the regular way as a primary division of that county, and, to make the presentation complete, the population is also shown, in *italics*, for the part outside that county and for the city or town as a whole.

NUMBER OF INHABITANTS

Metropolitan districts.—Metropolitan districts have been set up for use in the 1940 Census of Population in connection with each city of 50,000 or more, two or more such cities sometimes being in one district. The general plan is to include in the district, in addition to the central city or cities, all adjacent and contiguous minor civil divisions having a population of 150 or more per square mile. In some metropolitan districts a few less densely populated contiguous divisions are included on the basis of special qualifications. Only a portion of a minor civil division is included if the minor civil division has a large area and the principal concentration of population is in a small section near the central city with the more remote sections being sparsely settled. In such cases, the unit considered is not the minor civil division but component enumeration districts. (For example, not all of the enumeration districts in Black Dog township of Osage County are included in the Tulsa metropolitan district.) A metropolitan district is thus not a political unit but rather an area including all the thickly settled territory in and around a city or group of cities. It tends to be a more or less integrated area with common economic, social, and, often, administrative interests.

Table 7 shows the population of the Oklahoma City metropolitan district and its constituent political units in 1940 and 1930, together with the increase or decrease during the decade. In 1940 the Oklahoma City metropolitan district had 221,229 inhabitants, whereas in 1930 the district had a population of 202,163. The metropolitan district in 1940 had exactly the same area as in 1930.

Table 7-A shows the population of the Tulsa metropolitan district and its constituent political units in 1940 and 1930, together with the increase or decrease during the decade. In 1940 the Tulsa metropolitan district had 188,562 inhabitants, whereas in 1930 the district had a population of 183,207. The metropolitan district in 1940 had exactly the same area as in 1930.


Census tracts.—Census tracts are small areas into which certain large cities (and sometimes their adjacent areas) are subdivided, for statistical and local administrative purposes, through cooperation with a local committee in each case. The tracts are permanently established, so that comparisons may be made from census to census; they are laid out with a view to approximate uniformity in population and with some regard for uniformity in area; and each is designed to include an area fairly homogeneous in population characteristics. In table 8 the 1940 population of Oklahoma City is shown by census tracts; this table also gives the population in 1940 by tracts of certain adjacent areas, shown on the accompanying maps. Since these tracts were not established until after 1930, there are no comparative figures for earlier censuses.




